COVID-19 Pandemic

As we continue preparing to welcome back students, faculty and staff, and visitors to our campuses across the Texas Tech University System, it is imperative that we remain focused on the health, safety and well-being of our campus communities.

In an effort to be a strong community partner and to help minimize the spread of the coronavirus, the TTU System and its component universities require all individuals hosting or participating in an event on a TTU System institution's property to comply with our campus event policy.

There is additional information about the campus event policy requirements, in addition to the exceptions to the regulation, included in the <u>TTUS Campus Event Policy</u>, also included in this communication.

We'd ask that you share this policy with your respective campus communities. Doing so ensures that our campus constituents, and community partners, who are planning upcoming events on university property have the appropriate information and guidance.
