LANGUAGE TRANSFER CREDIT

Students who enter ASU with previous language qualifications will receive undergraduate transfer credit hours if they can demonstrate proficiency. Scores from the Defense Language Institute may be used to demonstrate proficiency. You can even receive credit for languages outside of ASU'S current offerings.

TRANSFER CREDITS FOR OTHER MILITARY SERVICE

All military and veteran students are evaluated on a case-by-case basis for additional transfer credits.

- Air Force: All 64 credit hours of the CCAF associate degree transfer to ASU.
- Army, Navy and Marines: ASU accepts Central Texas College associate degree transfer credits.
- House Bill 269: Within the terms of this legislation, you can choose up to 12 transferable hours of available military service credit to apply toward your degree plan. Asu awards additional credits for those who have more than 12 hours of transferable credit.
- College Credit for Heroes: This grant program administered by the Texas Workforce Commission allows Asu to maximize college credit awarded to veterans and service members for their military experience.
