Once submitted to ttus.valuesculture@ttu.edu, the form will be reviewed by the rewards and recognition team who will then create the letter. The letter will be sent to the individual being rewarded (printed letter and email) and their supervisor (email).
Values Hero letters will be placed in the employee's file and will be used to determine who is eligible to receive a challenge coin.
