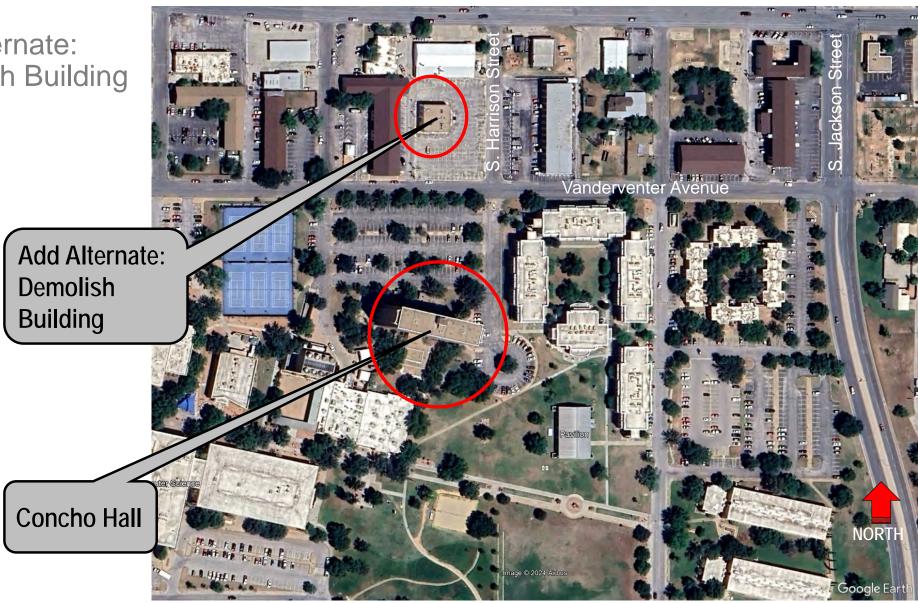

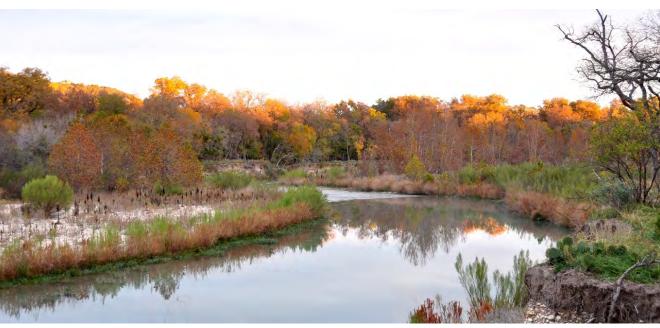

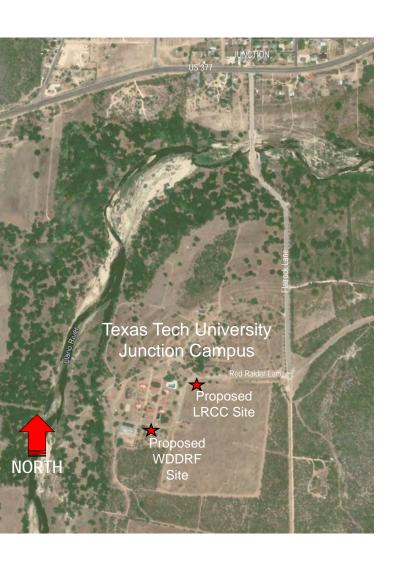


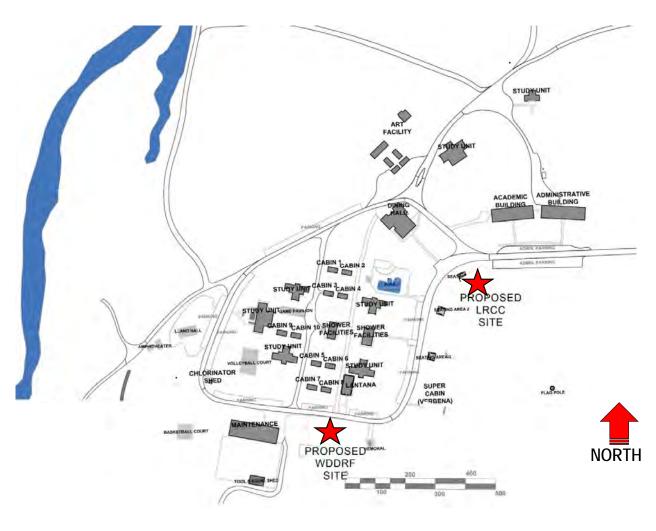






TTU Junction Campus Site Plan





Project Overview - Wildlife Disease and Deer Research Facility

- Standalone research/lab facility with approximately 1,000 1,500 GSF to include the following:
 - BSL2 compliant research lab:
 - Chemical fume hood and storage cabinet.
 - Autoclave.
 - Lab ice machine, lab glass washer.
 - Refrigerator, freezers, and storage racks.
 - General storage space, custodial space, and restroom.

Project Overview - Llano River Conservation Center

- Multipurpose conference facility with approximately 7,000 7,500 GSF to accommodate a minimum of 200-persons for meetings or events. The facility will include:
 - Reception/gathering entry area.
 - Large multipurpose room.
 - Catering/food serving and storage areas.
 - Classrooms.
 - Specimen storage.
 - Academic and staff offices.
 - General storage space, custodial space, and restrooms.
 - Exterior teaching space.

Project Overview (cont.)

- The project will also include:
 - Flexibility to dim/darken exterior lighting within the parking and facility areas for special astrologic viewing events.
 - Utilities required for the new facilities.
 - New permeable parking with ADA access.

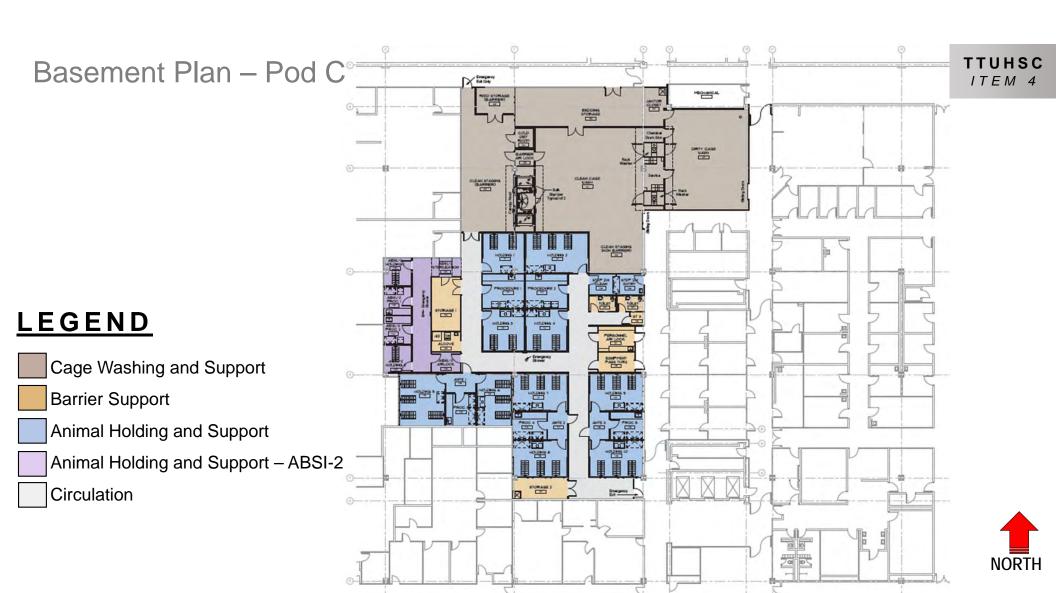

Project Overview

- Project will expand the existing Lubbock LARC vivarium by approximately 13,962 GSF in order to meet the current and future needs of the TTUHSC research community.
- The expansion has been designed to aid in elevating research at TTUHSC by creating a facility that meets contemporary industry standards for research animal housing.
- Project will incorporate innovative technologies and advanced built-in equipment necessary for the future needs of principal investigators.
- The expansion will create a dedicated bio-exclusion (barrier) facility adjacent to the existing vivarium with the flexibility to house multiple species.

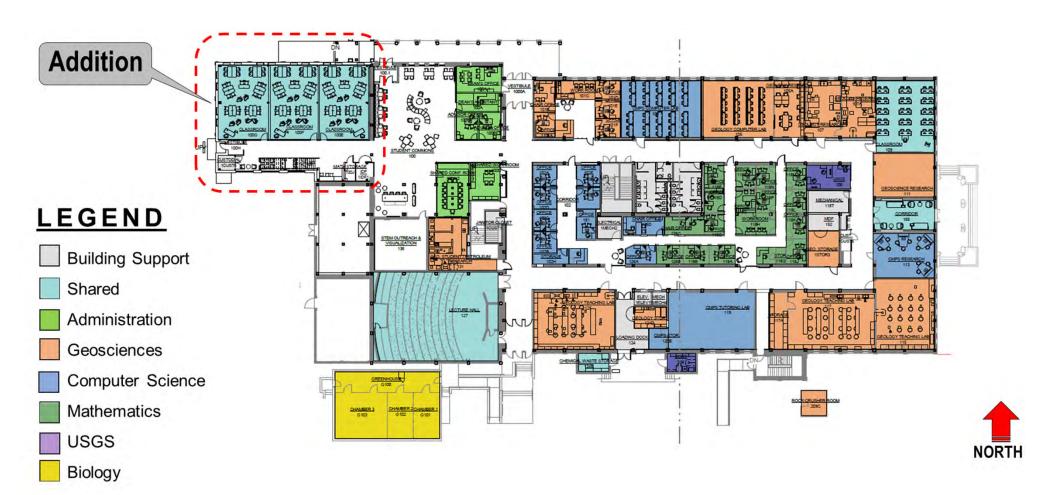

Project Overview

- Partial renovation of approximately 93,494 GSF of the existing building and provide 7,500 GSF of new space to address programmatic needs.
- Upgrade, replace, and retro-commission the existing mechanical, electrical, and plumbing building systems to gain energy efficiencies as well as comply with the current energy and building codes. This will include:
 - Addition to a recently installed partial fire sprinkler system, replacement of the pneumatic control system with Andover digital controls.
 - Replacement/retrofit of air handling equipment.
 - Upgrade of electrical switchgear and transformers.
 - Replacement of the existing network system.
 - Provide a new temperature control system for the greenhouse.
 - Accessibility upgrades.
