What is It?





- **Heat Map** graphically illustrates, in a comparative format, data in four dimensions. Impact, Likelihood, Preparedness and Velocity
- **Data Entry** use the "Table" tab. All other tabs are protected.
- **Printed Map** after data entry select the "Graph" tab to print your map.
- Maximum Data points you may map up to 8 risks on one map




