




LOCATION MAP

Amarillo Campus Site Plan






Architect's Concept Rendering – Main Entry







Scope of Services

- The approval grants authority for execution of Design Professional Stage II services consisting of:
 - Design development;
 - Construction documents;
 - Construction Administration Phases;
 - Statement of Probable Cost; and
 - Project Schedule.

Project Overview

- Four-year School of Veterinary Medicine is expected to serve approximately 240 Doctor of Veterinary Medicine students, with an additional 150 to 200 non-DVM graduate students and an estimated FTE faculty and staff of 90.
- Program, design and construct the combined approximate 270,000 GSF which includes 25,660 GSF of shelled space, programmed between two separate facilities on separate sites.
- The high-tech veterinary teaching/research facilities will serve both small and large animals.
- Each facility shall be designed to accommodate future growth.

Recommendation

- Approve expenditures of \$6,965,099 for a total of \$8,421,682 for the new School of Veterinary Medicine project with an anticipated total project budget of \$89,820,000; and authorize Design Professional Stage II services.
- The expenditures will be funded with the Revenue Finance System ("RFS") repaid with gift funds.
- The current total of expenditures includes the previously board authorized expenditures from appropriated funds related to the feasibility study (\$1,456,583).
